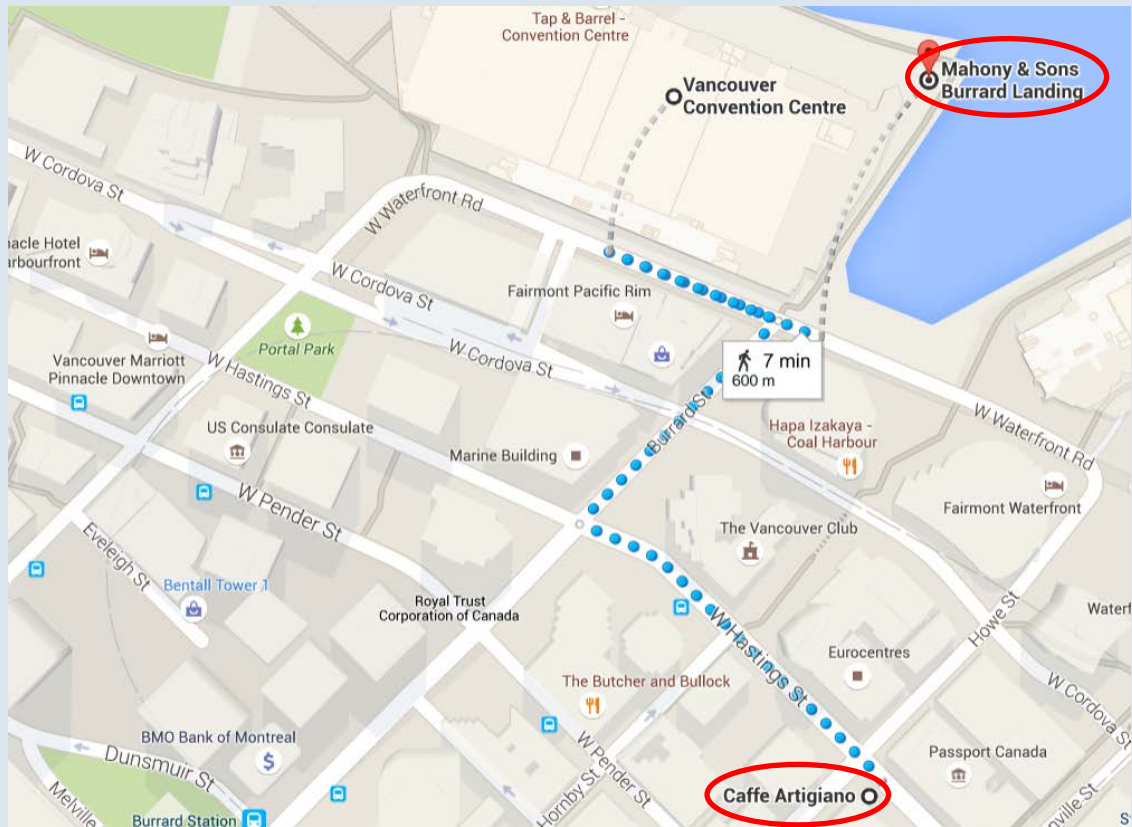
MEET & GREET SAP!
